Price for participation

We are trying to make participation possible for anyone by offering advantageous prices at self-cost. This is also being enforced by donations of the participating asatru groups and lots of volunteer work. Individual donations are most welcome! Please deposit into giro number 899565 in the name of M. de Nijs Heemskerk.

All prices include lodging and food - three meals a day as well as coffee, tea and water included with the meals. Beverages and alcoholic drinks will have to be brought or bought on-site separately.

Category 1

Members of the affiliated asatru groups and their families enrolment from March the first:

115 €- per person whole week - tent area

135 €- per person whole week - cabin

Category 2

All other persons not affiliated with the participating Asatru groups enrolment from April the first:

135 €- per person whole week - tent area

155 €- per person whole week - cabin

Reductions

Children: children up to age 5 are free and for children aged 6 to 15 all prices are reduced by 50%. Maximum payment per family will be for 2 adults and 2 children, regardless of age or price category. Persons who have a need to get a room in the cabin due to health reasons only have to pay the tent price and will be preferred in assigning a cabin place.

Bookings can be cancelled regularly until June 30th including the payback of money, not afterwards (except for special reasons). If total payment has not been received until June 30th the booking will be cancelled.

Participants are welcome on Saturday the 25th from 17.00 hours and we have to leave on Saturday the 1st of August before 16.00 hours.

Household chores like cooking, doing the dishes and cleaning we do ourselves, which means all participants will have to help out with this and other things. This includes tidy up and cleaning the premises the last day.

The IASC Code of Conduct

The International Asatru Summercamp has the aim of bringing together asatruar for the furthering of understanding between asatruar, the knowledge of the different aspects and practices of asatru and hence expanding our horizon on asatru today.

As a participant at the IASC you commit yourself to comply with the IASC Code of Conduct.

- Each participant at the IASC is expected to treat the other participants with respect and to conduct him- or herself honourably.
- Racist or discriminatory conduct, and more generally: causing a nuisance at the IASC for other participants and/or the area wherein the IASC is held, will lead to the expulsion from the IASC of the person(s) concerned.
- The IASC Council reserves the right to exclude individuals or groups, of which it has reason to suspect that they might not comply with this code of conduct or otherwise threaten to upset the frithgarth, of the IASC.
- The organizations involved in setting up the IASC cannot be held responsible for the acts and/or deeds of individual participants at the IASC. The IASC and its organizers carries no collective responsibility. They are also not responsible for damage arising during the IASC and inflicted on persons or personal property.

Please note that due to Danish law indoor smoking is prohibited.

Dogs and other pets are allowed at the camp. They are always the responsibility of their owners and should be kept on a leash if necessary.

All problems and violations within the Code of Conduct will be taken care of by the IASC Council.

The IASC Council

The Council consists of one representative from each of the organizing organizations.

The Council will take care of all disputes that may arise within the terms defined in the Code of Conduct.

The Council will also take care of other disputes that may arise amongst participants if these disputes in any way could hamper the camp. If a dispute arises the Council will assemble immediately.

Things brought before the council will be taken care of by the following procedure:

- 1) The people involved in the matter are entitled to tell the version of the matter to the Council. They speak one at the time and may not be interrupted.
- 2) The members of the council may then ask questions to the case.
- 3) The Council will then retire and find a solution to the matter.
- 4) The solution will be announced through a spokesperson elected by the council.

The decisions of the IASC Council are final.

Faliure to comply with the decisions of the Council will result in imediate expolsure from the IASC.
